Bois de Chênes

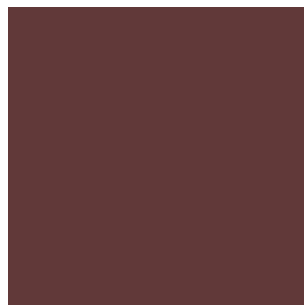
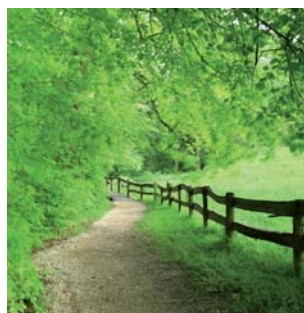
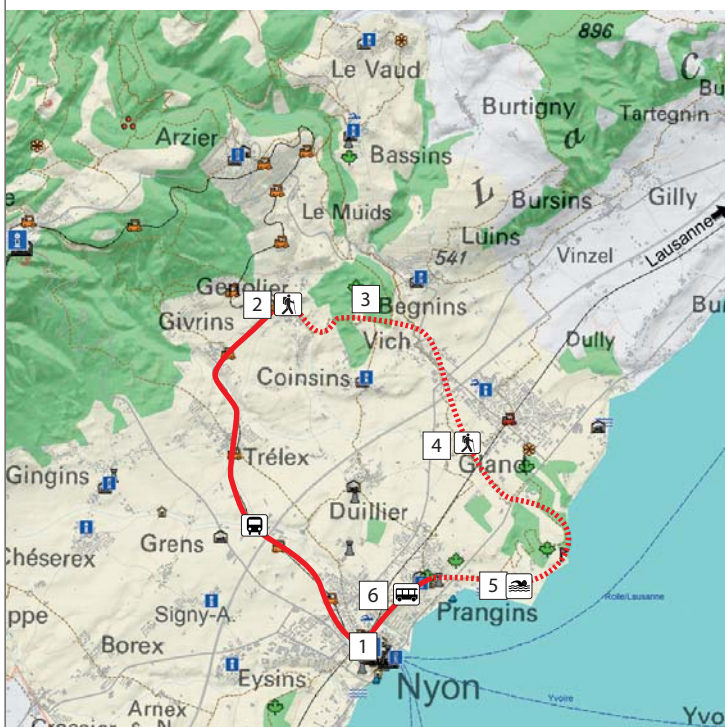
Nyon > Genolier > Gland > Nyon



Embedded between the villages of Genolier and Vich, Nature lovers can appreciate beautiful trails in the forest of "Bois de Chênes". It is accessible by train from Genolier and by bus from Vich. The wide open forest offers picnic and barbecue places for the whole family. After a nice meal you can follow the "Toblerones path" towards the lake shore and appreciate a refreshing swim in the lake of Geneva at the beach of "Promenthoux".

ITINERARY	DETAILS
1 NYON > GENOLIER	Departure from the underground trainstation of the NStCM in Nyon to Genolier. The one-way ticket is available at the counter or from the machine. Departure: 9:56 am - Length of time: 12 minutes
2 GENOLIER > BOIS DE CHÊNES	From the trainstop you go down towards the center of the village from where you can follow the yellow pedestrian signs, which guide you to the "Bois de Chênes".
3 BOIS DE CHÊNES	The "Bois de Chênes" is a protected natural area rich of waterspots and prairies which invite you for long walks and open-air picnics.
4 BOIS DE CHÊNES PROMENTHOUX	If you follow the signs towards Vich you will eventually fall on the "Toblerone path" which will take you down to the lake. Duration: 2 hours
OPTION 1/2 DAY – Return to Nyon by bus from Vich. Départures: 1:03 pm / 2:03 pm - Length of time: 20 minutes	
5 PLAGES DE PROMENTHOUX	Take a break at the beach of "Promenthoux" and go for a nice swim in the lake. (entrance fee) Open: 7/7, from 9 to 6 p.m (Mai to September)
6 PROMENTHOUX > NYON	following the signs "Sentier des Toblerones" towards Nyon, you will hit the main cantonal street from where you do have the possibility to take the bus to Nyon (Busstop Sadex) Departure: 4:07, 5:07 p.m - Length of time: 8 minutes
