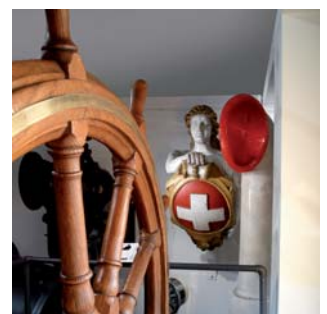
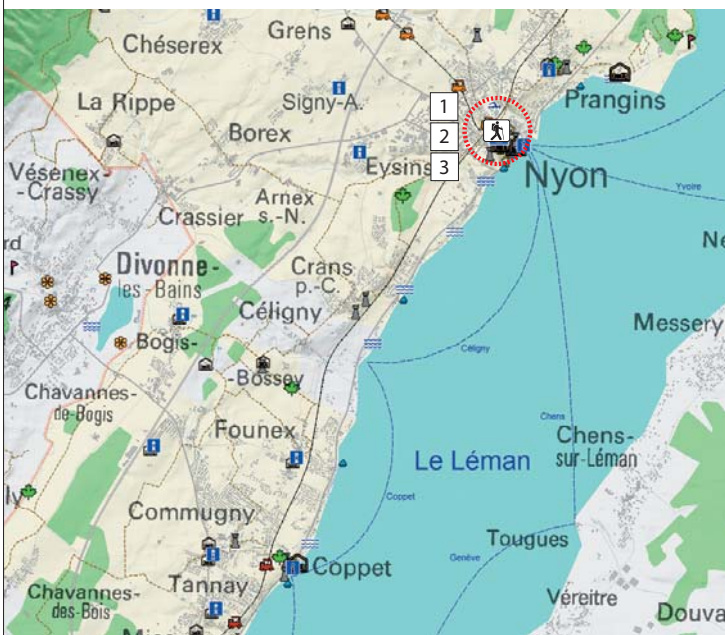


Nyon offers 3 museums to all cultural, patrimony and tradition lovers. Start with the "Musée du Léman" which shows the culture and nature of the most important lake of western Europe. Continue with the roman museum where you will dive into the heart of the roman city Novidunum, which was founded by Julius Cesar. Finally, end your tour in the recently renovated castle. You can enjoy a magnificent porcelaine exposition and walk through the history of Nyon in the historical museum. At the end of the visit the wine cellar invites you to taste some excellent wines from the region.

ITINERARY	DETAILS
1 MUSEE DU LEMAN	The "Musée du Léman" is located in the "Rive" area and situated right opposite of the harbour. Discover 1000 m2 of fix and temporary expositions about the nature and culture of the most important west european lake. Open: Tu-Su 10.00 am to 5.00 pm (Nov-Apr 2.00 pm to 5.00 pm) www.museeduleman.ch
2 MUSEE ROMAIN	From the "Rive" area you go up across the park "parc du Bourg" towards the roman columns. Keep walking a long the "Rue du vieux marché" until you reach the "Esplanade Jules Cesar" under wich the roman museum is located. In there you can discover the ruins of Noviodunum, one of the most important roman colonies in Switzerland. Open: Tu-Su 10.00 am to 5.00 pm (Nov-Apr 2.00 pm to 5.00 pm) www.mrn.ch
3 MUSEE HISTORIQUE ET DES PORCELAINES	Just a few steps away from the roman Museum you will see the castle. In there you will find the 3rd Museum of Nyon. After six years of renovation the whole building is open to the public and lots of new expositions await you. Open: Tu-Su 10 am to 5 pm (Nov-Apr 2.00 pm to 5.00 pm) www.chateaudenyon.ch . In a wine cellar on the lower floor you get the chance to degustate excellent wines from the region. Open: Fr and Sa 2.00 pm to 9.00 pm, So 11.00 am to 2.00 pm and 2.00 pm to 5.00 pm
